ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES

Welcome to Snow Country Ski Club Smiggins Lodge and thank you for supporting the Club by utilizing the accommodation facilities at Smiggin Holes. We hope you enjoy your stay. Please make yourself and your children and/or guests aware of the accommodation guidelines set out below.

- Snow Country's Lodges at Smiggins and Jindabyne adopt a smoke free policy.
- Room occupation is permitted after 2.00pm on day of arrival.
- Room allocations will be posted on the notice board at the bottom of the stairs.
- If Breakfast or Lunch is required on day of arrival, please notify the Lodge Managers at least 24 hrs prior to your arrival.
- Additional casual meals can be purchased for Breakfast, Lunch or Dinner. The cost for these can be found in the Accommodation Booking Form or by liaising with the Lodge Managers for current prices.
- Linen, pillows and doonas are supplied by the Club.
- Bath towels are NOT supplied.
- All guests are expected to adhere to the Duty Roster located in each room.
- Children 4 years and over may be accommodated at the Smiggins Lodge.
- Parents are requested to ensure that children are supervised at all times.
- Supervision of children less than 10 years of age is encouraged in the upper Mezzanine games area.
- Members/Guests should report any damage to buildings or equipment to the Managers as soon as possible.
- Self-pack take away lunches are available for your use anytime during your stay.
- Soft drinks are available for sale from the Lodge Managers.
- Hot beverages (Instant Coffee and Tea) as well as snacks are available for your use anytime.
- A Nespresso Coffee Machine is installed, please bring your own Nespresso Pods if you like that type of coffee.
- All Members and Guests are expected to clean up after themselves.
- The Member/Guest Fridge is located just inside the kitchen and in the upstairs bar area.
- The Managers Kitchen is strictly out of bounds to all Members and Guests.
- Clothes Washing and Drying facilities are available for your use, please ask our Lodge Managers to direct you.
- Please consider the other Members/Guests in the Lodge by Keeping the noise level to a minimum.
- Rooms must be cleared and vacated by 11.00am on your day of departure.
- Please vacuum your vacated room and empty the rubbish bin. Please strip the bed/s and deposit dirty linen in the basket supplied in the downstairs foyer. Members and Guests are responsible for the cleaning of their room when leaving. If you do not wish to do this, the Managers will do it for a fee. Please make arrangements the day before you leave.
- Ski boots or wet shoes are not to be worn on any of the carpeted areas of the Lodge.
- General courtesy and etiquette is expected of all Members and Guests, including appropriate dress during meal times.
- Members and Guests are requested to refrain from using electronic devices (e.g : mobile phones, portable DVD players, laptop computers. Hand held electronic games, portable televisions etc) in the common areas of the Lodge, prior to 9.00am and after 5.00pm - 7 days a week.

It is the Managers responsibility to ensure these guidelines are adhered to, and your full cooperation is appreciated.
