Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much is it to join?

The cost to join is \$5300. This comprises 50 shares totaling \$100, a joining fee of \$4950 (non-refundable) and annual fees of \$250.

2. What about other family members?

The first shareholder in a family pays the full fees. Additional members of the family pay a reduced joining fee and a lower annual fee. Children 21 years of age and older are considered as new adult members, so pay the full joining fees.

3. What are the benefits of being a shareholder?

Shareholders benefits include lower accommodation rates, priority for booking accommodation, participation in Club ski training programs and inter club ski sports, are welcome to attend Club social activities, may transfer their shares to other members of their family, and are entitled to vote at the Annual General Meeting.

4. What's involved in being a club member?

The Club is run by shareholders (also called members) who act in an honorary capacity. There is an opportunity for every member to assist in Club administration, ski training and competitions, social events and work parties. Those who have become involved have developed rich friendships and great satisfaction in helping build and maintain the club.

5. What is the Ski Training Program?

During the ski season Club runs a Junior Ski Race Training Program. We aim to encourage our junior members to improve their skills in ski racing—downhill/cross-country or snowboarding at specified training periods organized by the club.

6. How do I join?

Fill out the attached application form and send it to the Club Secretary. New applicants need to be supported by 3 existing (non-related) members or be interviewed by a few board members.
